Inaugural lecture of the 3rd International Interdisciplinary Technical Conference for Young Scientists InterTech 2010, entitled "The Urgent Need for an Intellectual Revolution: From Knowledge to Wisdom" will be given by dr Nicholas Maxwell. For nearly thirty years he taught philosophy of science at University College London. In 2003 he founded Friends of Wisdom, an international group of people sympathetic to the idea that academic inquiry should help humanity acquire more wisdom by rational means. Dr Nicholas Maxwell is willing to share with the participants of InterTech 2010 the secrets of knowledge and wisdom.
