

## Entrance Examination and Interview

### (PhD Admission 2025/2026)

Candidates applying for the **PhD Programme in Mathematics** will take part in an **interview worth up to 20 points**.

The interview is qualifying; any candidate who receives fewer than 10 points in the interview will not be eligible for enrolment.

Candidates applying for the **PhD Programme in Informatics** will take an **integrated entrance examination in Mathematics and Informatics**, carrying a total of 20 points.

A candidate who is not exempt from the entrance examination and fails to appear for the exam will lose the right to enrol.

Furthermore, each candidate must submit **two written recommendations** from university professors; failure to submit these will result in the loss of the right to enrol.

Candidates applying for the **PhD Programme in Astronomy and Astrophysics** will take part in an **interview worth up to 20 points**.

The interview is qualifying; any candidate who receives fewer than 10 points in the interview will not be eligible for enrolment.

#### 1. Technical Information

- Candidates must arrive at the examination or interview venue **at least fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled start**.
- Candidates must bring a **valid ID card or passport** used during online application.
- Candidates **must know their application number**, as provided in the confirmation email after completing the online application.
- **Pencils and notebooks will be provided by the invigilators on site.**
- The use of **calculators, mobile phones, tablets, smartwatches, geometry sets, reference sheets**, or any other unauthorised materials is **strictly prohibited**. All such items must be left in the designated area before the start of the examination.
- Candidates are advised to bring a **bottle of water** to the entrance examination.

The Faculty will ensure that all updates are made available in a timely and transparent manner.
